\* **NOTE on Water Management Permit Implementation:** MassDEP adopted revised Water Management Regulations at 310 CMR 36.00 in November 2014. The regulations reflect a carefully developed balance to protect the health of our water bodies while meeting the needs of businesses and communities for water.

Since that time, MassDEP has been working closely with each Water Management Act permittee to fully consider all aspects of their individual situations and ensure thoughtful and implementable permits.

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, section 13, and 310 CMR 36.18(7), if a permit renewal application is filed by the filing deadline, the existing permit will be administratively continued in force and effect until MassDEP issues a final decision on the renewal application. Final permit issuance dates listed below are tentative and will depend on the consultation process and time needed to develop permits that incorporate all regulatory requirements.

\*\* **Permit Extension Act:** Section 173 of the Chapter 240 of the Acts of 2010, as amended by Chapter 238 of the Acts of 2012, collectively known as the Permit Extension Act, extended all permits by 4 years beyond their original expiration date.
