



WALLIS RESERVOIR (DOUGLAS) 216 Acres

General Information: Whitin Reservoir, also known as Wallis Reservoir is a warmwater reservoir located in Douglas. The average depth is 14 feet with a maximum of 28 feet.

Access: Boat access is available off Wallis St.

Management History: Managed as a warmwater fishery.

Fish Populations: A fish population survey was conducted during the summer of 1992. Ten species were collected including chain pickerel, black crappie, yellow & white perch, bluegill, pumpkinseed, yellow & brown bullhead, white sucker and golden shiners.
