





Little Chauncy Pond

General Information:

Little Chauncy Pond, a Great Pond, offers anglers an opportunity to fish in a relatively unspoiled, tranquil environment. With no cottages or houses along its shoreline, Little Chauncy can provide hours of enjoyable fishing in a natural setting, either from shore or in a small boat.

Recreational Access:

Little Chauncy is located just north of Big Chauncy Pond and accessed from a dirt road off of Lyman Street. The dirt ramp (71°36'52.605"W 42°18'18.475"N) is suitable only for small boats and canoes, and is part of the Wayne F. MacCallum Wildlife Management Area (formerly Westborough WMA). There is enough room for about 5 cars to park. The parking area can become quite muddy during rainy periods in the spring.

Fish Populations:

Little Chauncy Pond is managed as a warmwater fishery. The fish population based on Division surveys includes: Bluegills, Golden Shiners, Yellow Perch, Black Crappie, Pumpkinseed, Largemouth Bass, White Perch, Yellow Bullheads, Chain Pickerel and Brown Bullhead.

Fishing:

Little Chauncy Pond is an excellent spot for catching panfish, bass, or pickerel. You should be able to catch a lot of fish, but don't expect too many large "keepers". This is a nice place to introduce children to the sport of fishing. Little Chauncy has produced trophy-sized fish through the Division's Freshwater Sportfishing Award Program, including Bullhead, Chain Pickerel, and Sunfish. It is a fairly good pond for Yellow Perch during the ice fishing season.
