### NOTICE OF WORKSHOPS IN JANUARY AND FEBRUARY 2015

**WORKSHOP DATES:** January 27, January 29, February 12, February 26 (2), 2015.

The Energy Efficiency Advisory Council ("Council") established pursuant to section 22 of Chapter 25 of the Massachusetts General Laws announces the creation of five (5) workshops by and for the members of the Council. The Council has elected a workshop format to educate its members in a more focused and concentrated manner concerning critical priorities and opportunities potentially available in each of the three customer sectors in the delivery of energy efficiency programs: (1) Residential, (2) Low-Income and (3) Commercial & Industrial. Each of these workshops is intended to inform the members of the Council in their determination of priorities and identification of opportunities in energy efficiency as they begin to consider the formulation of the Third Statewide Three-Year Energy Efficiency Investment Plans for the Years 2016 through 2018.

The first two workshops will be held in Boston. On **January 27, 2015 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm** at *100 Cambridge Street, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Conference Rooms C + D, Boston, Massachusetts 02114*, there will be a workshop that will focus on priorities and opportunities in the **Commercial & Industrial Sector**. On **January 29 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm** at *One South Station, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, in DPU Hearing Room A, Boston, Massachusetts*, the Council has scheduled a workshop which will address priorities and opportunities in the **Residential Sector**.

The following three workshops will take place at the offices of the *Division of Fisheries & Wildlife ("DFW") Headquarters, One Rabbit Hill Road in Westborough, Massachusetts 01581*. On **February 12 from 9:00 am until 1:00 pm** there will be a workshop that will concentrate on priorities and opportunities in the **Commercial & Industrial Sector**. **February 26 from 9:00 am until 12:30 pm** there will be a workshop that will take up priorities and opportunities in the **Residential Sector**. Later, **that same day, from 1:30 pm until 5:00 pm**, there will be a workshop to appraise priorities and opportunities in the **Low-Income Sector**.
