ENERGY EFFICIENCY ADVISORY COUNCIL **NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED APRIL PUBLIC MEETING**

The Energy Efficiency Advisory Council (“Council”) established pursuant to section 22 of Chapter 25 of the Massachusetts General Laws announces the re-scheduling of the time for the Council meeting of April 20, 2016.

The Council announces that its April 20 meeting will now convene at 1:00 pm and conclude at 4:00 pm or such time as the Council concludes its business. The rescheduled Council meeting will still take place in Conference Rooms B + C on the Second Floor of 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02108, to have continued discussion and consideration regarding Peak Demand reduction and other demand issues, technologies and practices, as they are key components within the Three-Year Energy Efficiency Investment Plans (“EEIPs”). There may also be an update from the Demand Savings Group concerning its recent Report to the DPU.

The EEAC may also take up any and all general business of the Council incidental to the operation of these EEIPs, which are administered by electric distribution companies, natural gas distribution companies, and a municipal aggregator.
