ENERGY EFFICIENCY ADVISORY COUNCIL **NOTICE OF NEW DATE FOR MAY PUBLIC MEETING**

The Energy Efficiency Advisory Council (“Council”) established pursuant to section 22 of Chapter 25 of the Massachusetts General Laws announces the re-scheduling of the date for its meeting in May.

The Council announces that its previously scheduled meeting for May 18, 2016 has been cancelled. In its place, the Council will now hold its meeting on Wednesday, May 25, 2016. This meeting will convene at 12:00 pm and conclude at 4:00 pm or such time as the Council concludes its business. The Council meeting will still take place in Conference Rooms B + C on the Second Floor of 100 Cambridge Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02108. The Council plans an extended discussion and consideration of Evaluation, Measurement and Verification (“EM+V”) findings and issues arising from the First Quarter report of Year One of the Program Administrators’ 2016-2018 Three-Year Energy Efficiency Investment Plans. Presentations by both the PAs and the Council Consultants are expected.

The EEAC may also take up any and all general business of the Council incidental to the operation of these EEIPs, which are administered by electric distribution companies, natural gas distribution companies, and a municipal aggregator.
