### NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED DEMAND REDUCTION SUBCOMMITTEE MEETING

The Energy Efficiency Advisory Council (“Council”) established pursuant to section 22 of Chapter 25 of the Massachusetts General Laws announces two meetings of its Demand Reduction Subcommittee. The second meeting of the Demand Reduction Subcommittee will now occur on a different date and a new location. **This meeting will now occur on March 10, 2016 from 10:00 am until 11:30 am or until such time as the business of the meeting has concluded. This meeting will take place in the Dondis Library within the offices of RichMay, P.C. on 176 Federal Street, Boston, Massachusetts 02110.** The Demand Reduction Subcommittee, with the assistance of its EEAC Consultant Team, will provide feedback to efforts of the Program Administrators’ Demand Savings Group in its consideration, preparation and implementation of various demonstration projects in the field utilizing demand response tools and measures. This subcommittee expects: to pose questions, conduct discussion, and generally respond to ideas and proposals put forth by the Program Administrators’ Demand Savings Group prior to the submission of a Report to be filed by the Program Administrators’ Demand Savings Group on or before March 31, 2016 with the Department of Public Utilities. In addition, this Demand Reduction Subcommittee will report to the full Council apprising same of its interactions with the Demand Savings Group.
