State Environmental Officials Gather for Swearing-in of
Fisheries and Wildlife Board Member George Darey of Lenox

WHAT: Secretary of Energy and Environmental Affairs Ian Bowles will administer the oath of office to George Darey of Lenox as a member of the Massachusetts Fisheries and Wildlife Board. Darey will be sworn in for a seventh term on the board he has chaired since 1981.

WHERE: Shakespeare & Company, 70 Kemble Street, Lenox, MA

DIRECTIONS: From Boston and points east: Take Exit 2 off the Mass Pike (Rte. 90) to Rte. 20 W through Lee for 3.1 miles, then turn left on Plunkett Street. Watch for the blue highway sign on the right. Travel for 1.7 miles (through Rt. 7 traffic light) to Shakespeare & Co on the left side of Kemble Street. From Pittsfield and points north: Take Rte. 7 S to Rte. 7A/Kemble Street (watch for the blue highway sign on left). Turn right at the light. Shakespeare & Co is 0.9 mile ahead. From Stockbridge and points south: Take Rte. 7 N for 5 miles to the first traffic signal, Rte. 7A/Kemble Street (watch for the blue highway sign on right). Turn left at the Rte. 7A/Kemble Street traffic signal. Shakespeare & Co is 0.9 mile ahead.
