APPLICANTS FOR TEMPORARY LICENSURE

Visiting Short-Term Faculty With/Without Lapsed Full License

Physicians who wish to serve as visiting faculty in an accredited hospital associated with a medical school in Massachusetts, for not more than thirty days, may receive a temporary license if evidence of the following information, which is satisfactory to the Board, is submitted:

- 1a. Eligibility for a temporary license pursuant to M.G.L. c.112, § 9B(1);

OR

- 1b. Eligibility for a temporary license pursuant to M.G.L. c.112, § 9B(1) AND holding a lapsed full Massachusetts license;
2. Letters from department chief and institutional administrator at accredited hospital, confirming applicant's short-term faculty appointment;
3. Applicant's curriculum vitae;
4. Letter of licensure in good standing from all states or countries where applicant is currently practicing;
- 5a. Confirmation of current or previous faculty appointment in Massachusetts or another state or country;

OR

- 5b. Evidence of recognized achievement in a field of medicine, which is the subject of the Massachusetts faculty appointment.
