About our Keynote Presentation

Lydia Ayala, Alzheimer's manager at the Kennedy Center, Inc., in Trumbull, CT will present two videos produced by the Kennedy Center on Alzheimer's Disease and Down syndrome. The first video, "Everyday is Different" provides factual information about Alzheimer's Disease. The second video, "I am the Setting Sun", follows the lives of two people in their early 50's who have Down Syndrome and now have Alzheimer's Disease. Through interviews with families and others, the focus is on how the disease impacts the person and his or her family as well as strategies for best "managing" the course of the illness.
