
CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR REPRIMAND

The Massachusetts Board of Registration of Nursing Home Administrators (the "Board") and Thomas Lynch, holder of Nursing Home Administrator ("NHA") License No. NH3567 (the "Licensee"), hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into, and become a permanent part of, Licensee's records that are maintained by the Board:


1. The Board issued to the Licensee a license to practice as a Nursing Home Administrator ("NHA"), License No. NH3567, on or about September 3, 2004.
2. The Licensee's NHA license expired on June 30, 2010.
3. The Licensee acknowledges that following the expiration of his NHA license on June 30, 2010, he continued, while unlicensed, to practice as a NHA at the Bostonian Nursing Care and Rehabilitation Center in Dorchester, Massachusetts, and at the Marina Bay Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Quincy, Massachusetts, from July 1, 2010, to on or about December 15, 2011.
4. The Licensee agrees that this Consent Agreement for Reprimand (the "Consent Agreement" or the "Agreement") is executed in resolution of the complaint identified as Docket No. NHA-2011-012 (the "Complaint"), which alleges that the Licensee practiced as a NHA while unlicensed between July 1, 2010, and December 15, 2011. The Licensee acknowledges that the allegations contained in the Complaint provide sufficient grounds for the Board to take disciplinary action against his NHA license pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws ("M.G.L.") Chapter 112, sections 109 and 115, and Board regulations at 245 Code of Massachusetts Regulations ("CMR") 2.11 and 245 CMR 2.15(4).

5. In full resolution of the Complaint, and without the necessity of additional proceedings before the Board, the Licensee hereby accepts a REPRIMAND for the Licensee's unlicensed practice as a Nursing Home Administrator. The Licensee understands that a Reprimand constitutes disciplinary action by the Board.
6. The Licensee agrees to return to the Board at its office at 239 Causeway Street, Suite 500, Boston, Massachusetts 02114, either by hand or by mail, the **two (2)** enclosed duplicate originals of this Consent Agreement signed by the Licensee, witnessed and dated, **no later fourteen (14) days from his receipt of this Agreement.**
7. In consideration of the Licensee's execution of this Consent Agreement and full compliance with its terms, the Board agrees not to pursue any additional action before itself or any court based upon the allegations set forth in the Complaint.
8. The Licensee acknowledges that his decision to enter into this Consent Agreement is a final act and is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review.
9. The Licensee states that he has used legal counsel in connection with his decision to enter into this Consent Agreement or, if he has not used legal counsel, that the decision not to do so has been one taken of his own free will.
10. The Licensee understands that, after its Effective Date, set forth below, this Consent Agreement constitutes a "public record" within the meaning of M.G.L. c. 4, § 7 subject to public disclosure and that the Board may forward a copy of this Agreement to other licensing boards or law enforcement entities, or both, as well as to any other individual or entity as required by law.
11. The Licensee certifies that he has read this document entitled "Consent Agreement for Reprimand." He understands that he has a right to formal adjudication concerning the allegations against him and that during said adjudication he would possess the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on his own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the courts, and all other rights as set forth in the Massachusetts Administrative Procedures Act, M.G.L. c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 *et seq.* The Licensee further states that he understands that in executing this document entitled "Consent Agreement for Reprimand" he is knowingly and voluntarily waiving his right to formal adjudication and to all of the related rights listed above.
