CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR PERMANENT REVOCATION

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Nursing (Board) and Yanick Bleck (Licensee), a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) licensed by the Board, License No. LN88619, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the Licensee's record maintained by the Board:

1. The Licensee acknowledges that a complaint has been filed with the Board against her Massachusetts Licensed Practical Nurse license (license¹) related to the conduct set forth in paragraph 2, identified as Docket No. NUR-2015-0162 (the Complaint).
2. The Licensee admits that on or about August 22, 2011, she submitted or directed another person to submit, on her behalf, an application for licensure as a Licensed Practical Nurse by reciprocity. On her application, she indicated that the Guam Board of Nursing issued an LPN license (#2135) to her on November 22, 2001. The Licensee admits that the information was not truthful or accurate because she never possessed an LPN license from Guam. She admits that she submitted or directed another person to submit, on her behalf, fraudulent documents to obtain a Massachusetts LPN license. She further admits that she has presented herself as a duly licensed LPN in Massachusetts.

The Licensee acknowledges that her conduct constitutes a lack of Good Moral Character as it relates to the Board's Licensure Policy 00-01 and that said conduct fails to comply with the Board's Standards of Conduct at 244 Code of Massachusetts Regulations (CMR) 9.03(1), (34) and (47). She further acknowledges that her conduct warrants disciplinary action by the Board under

Massachusetts General Laws (G.L.) Chapter 112, sections 61, 74A and Board regulations at 244 CMR 7.04, Disciplinary Actions.

3. The Licensee agrees to a permanent revocation of her nursing license commencing with the date on which the Board signs this Agreement (Effective Date).
4. The Licensee agrees that she will not practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse in Massachusetts from the Effective Date².
5. The Board agrees that in return for the Licensee's execution of this Agreement it will not prosecute the complaint.
6. The Licensee understands that she has a right to formal adjudicatory hearing concerning the allegations against her. She understands that during said hearing she would possess the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on her own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the courts, and all other rights as set forth in the Massachusetts Administrative Procedures Act, G. L. c. 30A and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 *et seq.* The Licensee further understands that by executing this Agreement she is knowingly and voluntarily waiving her right to a formal adjudication of the complaint.
7. The Licensee acknowledges that she has been at all times free to seek and use legal counsel in connection with the complaint and this Agreement.
8. The Licensee acknowledges that after the Effective Date, the Agreement constitutes a public record of disciplinary action by the Board. The Board may forward a copy of this Agreement to other licensing boards, law enforcement entities, and other individuals or entities as required or permitted by law.
9. The Licensee certifies that she has read this Agreement. The Licensee understands and agrees that entering into this Agreement is a final act and not subject to reconsideration, appeal or judicial review.

² The Licensee understands that practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse includes, but is not limited to, seeking and/or accepting a paid or voluntary position as a Licensed Practical Nurse, or a paid or voluntary position requiring that the applicant hold a current Licensed Practical Nurse license. The Licensee further understands that if she accepts a voluntary or paid position as a Licensed Practical Nurse, or engages in any practice of nursing after the Effective Date, evidence of such practice shall be grounds for the Board's referral of any such unlicensed practice to the appropriate law enforcement authorities for prosecution, as set forth in G. L. c. 112, ss. 65 and 80A.
