

#### **--ADEX Periodontics Exam as Optional**

ADEX has announced that state Boards may opt not to require the Periodontics portion of the examination for licensure. This is based on two factors: 1) that the skills tested are among those largely performed by dental hygienists in current practice and 2) that almost all exam takers pass this section on the first try. Currently, Massachusetts requires an

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applicant to pass all portions of a Board-approved examination. The ADEX decision may affect our processing of applications for licensure by credential, as some applicants licensed in other states may not have completed the Periodontics portion of the examination.

### **PGY-1**

Dr. Milton Glicksman raised the issue of PGY-1 as a path to licensure in Massachusetts. Board members discussed pros and cons of this issue and agreed that the topic would remain on the Board's agenda in future months. Executive Director Atkinson will contact the Deans of the Massachusetts dental schools to see if they have further data from states that have been accepting PGY-1 licensees for a period of time.
