Target Issues

Address business development concerns that are difficult for one community to address on its own.

Improve

- Transportation
- Education and Workforce Development
- Infrastructure, Utilities & Real Estate Development

Promote and Market

- Route 3 Corridor and Area Businesses



MIDDLESEX 3: Transportation

Created a Transportation Committee

- Which consists of 35 public and private sector members
- Advocate for better transportation linkages between employees and existing businesses, including short-term and long-term goals.
- Advocate for transportation improvements – including road, infrastructure and alternative modes of transportation.

Community Innovation Challenge Grant

- \$147,000 from the Commonwealth for transportation coordination and improvements with Route 3 businesses & residents.
- Held series of business meeting regarding transportation concerns and shuttle service.

MIDDLESEX 3: Transportation

Middlesex 3 Transportation Management Association (M3 TMA)

- Created in November 2014, as a partnership between businesses and communities to provide
- Vanpools, carpools, other modes of transportation and an emergency ride home program,
- Transit benefits and ride matching,
- Shuttle services (between Boston, Cambridge and Route 3) and last mile connections.

M3 TMA Members with shuttle service from Boston and Cambridge include:

- The MITRE Corporation, E Ink, National Development, The District and The Davis Companies.

\$100,000 DEP Mitigation Funding

- Established \$20,000 in matching funds for first five companies that join M3 TMA and 12 month shuttle service.

MIDDLESEX 3: Transportation

Middlesex 3 Regional Transportation Community Compact

- Advocate for better linkages between public transportation services (i.e., LRTA and MBTA)

Middlesex 3 Restaurant Initiative

- Work with Lowell to address and help provide transportation for 350 job openings in Burlington

Community Transit Grant

- Enhanced Mobility for Seniors and Individuals with Disabilities
