Dr. Reese is an internationally known author, speaker and trainer in the specialty areas of stress management, leadership, workplace violence, and motivation. He is a board certified expert in Traumatic Stress and is a fellow of the American Academy of Experts in Traumatic Stress. A pioneer criminal profiler with the FBI’s Behavioral Science Unit, Dr. Reese worked with the cast of *Silence of the Lambs* and is often quoted on the popular television series, *Criminal Minds*.

A retired U.S. Army Colonel, Dave is an internationally recognized scholar, author, and speaker who is one of the world’s foremost experts in the field of human aggression and the roots of violence and violent crime. He is also one of the nation’s leading law enforcement trainers. Dave is a former Army Ranger, West Point psychology professor, and Professor of Military Science who drew on his combined experience to establish a new field of scientific endeavor that he has named “Killology”. He has served as an expert witness and consultant to numerous Federal and State courts, including *United States vs. Timothy McVeigh*.
