

**Court Commitments to  
Massachusetts County Facilities  
During 1987**

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### Abstract

This report provides a statistical description of the 10,818 offenders committed by the courts to Massachusetts county facilities (jail or house of correction) during 1987. The report presents information on institution committed to, court committed from, month of commitment, offense, sentence length, sentence type, age, sex, race, marital status, education, place of birth and residence.

Some highlights of the statistics presented in this report are:

- In 1987 there were 10,818 commitments to county facilities. This represents an increase of 3 percent over the number of commitments in 1986.
- In terms of general categories of offenses, 11 percent were committed for offenses against the person, 2 percent for sex offenses, 28 percent for property offenses, 9 percent for drug offenses, 24 percent for Operating Under the Influence (O.U.I.), and 25 percent for all other offenses.
- Specifically, the most common offenses for which offenders were committed were O.U.I. (24 percent), motor vehicle violations (13 percent), and burglary (9 percent).
- The median sentence length was three months. Twelve percent were committed in lieu of payment of a fine. One percent were serving weekend sentences.
- The median age of offenders committed to county facilities was 26 years.
- Seventy-six percent of the offenders were white, 16 percent were black and 8 percent were Hispanic.
- The median educational level was 12th grade.
- Seventy percent of the offenders were single, 17 percent were married and 13 percent were separated, divorced or widowed.
- Seventy percent were born in Massachusetts, 18 percent were born in other states, 8 percent were born in U.S. territories and 4 percent were foreign-born.

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## Introduction

This report provides a statistical description of offenders committed to Massachusetts county facilities (jails and houses of correction) during 1987. Included here is information about the county facilities and their operating expenditures. Offenders are described in terms of institution committed to, month of commitment, court committed from, offense, sentence length, sentence type (weekend and jail sentences), sex, age, race, marital status, education, place of birth, and residence. Trends in court commitments to the county correctional system over the past decade are also presented. The tables were derived from information submitted by each county facility to the Operations Research Unit of the Research Division in the Department of Correction and were produced on the Regent's Computer Network.

Upon referring to the statistical tables, the reader should note the following: (1) the total population is sub-divided by committing institution; (2) the top number in each cell represents the total number of offenders committed to a particular institution who fall into the corresponding category in that row of the table; and (3) the bottom number in each cell (the number contained in parentheses) is the percentage of the number of individuals in the category to the total number of individuals from that institution (column percents). For example, on page twelve, Month of Commitment is presented and the following types of information can be obtained:

- (1) The total number of offenders is broken down by commitment institution, and these are labeled and presented horizontally across the top of the table;
- (2) The specific months are labeled and presented vertically;
- (3) Of the 10,818 offenders committed during 1987, 2,041 were committed to the Middlesex County facility;
- (4) Of the 2,041 offenders committed to Middlesex County, nine percent (N=178) were committed in January.

### County Facilities in Massachusetts

There are fourteen counties in Massachusetts. All counties except for Nantucket County have at least one county correctional facility administered by the county sheriff. These facilities usually contain a jail, for pre-trial detainees, and a house of correction, for sentenced inmates. The location and administrators of all facilities are shown in Appendix I. Suffolk County has a separate facility for its jail (Charles Street) and its house of correction (Deer Island). The Deer Island House of Correction is administered by the Penal Commissioner of Boston. Middlesex County has two facilities, a combined jail and house of correction in Billerica and a jail in Cambridge. Essex County has two facilities that serve as jails and houses of correction, one in Lawrence and one in Salem. Four counties have specialized facilities for sentenced offenders: Essex County has the Correctional Alternative Center (CAC) in Lawrence; Hampden County has the Western Massachusetts Correctional Alcohol Center (WMCAC) facility in Springfield; Bristol County has the Eastern Massachusetts Correctional Alcohol Center (EMCAC); and Norfolk County has the Braintree Alternative Center. Individuals are not committed directly to these four facilities, but can be transferred from a house of correction or state correctional facility.

The twenty county facilities include ten 19th century facilities and ten built in the 20th century. The oldest facility is the Essex County facility in Salem built in 1813.


The operating expenditures for each county facility, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1987, are shown in Appendix II. These include expenses for salaries, food, utilities and other expenses.

The population in county correctional facilities for the period January 1, 1987 to December 31, 1987 is shown in Appendix III. This includes the average daily population (ADP), beginning and ending population, design capacity, and average daily population divided into design capacity, which is an indicator of facility utilization.

Commitments to County Correctional Facilities,  
1977 to 1987

During 1987 there were 10,818 commitments to county facilities. This is a 3 percent increase from the 10,516 commitments in 1986 and a 159 percent increase from the 4,169 commitments in 1977. Commitments to county facilities for the last eleven years are shown in Figure 1.

The largest increase in commitments came between 1981 and 1982 when there was an increase of 36 percent or 2,254 commitments. Much of this increase was due to changing legislation regarding O.U.I. offenders. Commitments for O.U.I. increased from 295 in 1981 to 1305 in 1982, an increase of 1,010.

Table 1 shows selected characteristics of offenders committed to the county correctional system during the six year period, 1982 to 1987. During this six year period, the number of commitments increased by 27 percent or 2,318, from 8,500 in 1982 to 10,818 in 1987. With the exception of the Suffolk County Jail at Charles Street, all county facilities experienced increases in commitments.

The offenses for which individuals were committed changed over the last six years. Increases occurred for drug offenses, motor vehicle offenses, O.U.I., person offenses, and sex offenses. There were decreases in commitments for property and other offenses. Commitments for drug offenses increased by 135 percent or 577; commitments for motor vehicle offenses increased by 118 percent or 768; commitments for O.U.I. increased by 100 percent or 1,302; commitments for sex offenses increased by 55 percent or 68; and commitments for person offenses increased by 13 percent or 138 during the period. Commitments for property offenses decreased by 14 percent or 480; and commitments for all other offenses decreased by 4 percent or 55.

The length of sentences have increased over the past years. In 1982, 44 percent of commitments had a sentence of one month or less (including fines); and in 1987, 35 percent of all commitments had a sentence of one month or less.

The age distribution of county commitments shifted upward over the last six years. In 1982, 54 percent of the commitments were 24 years or younger and 46 percent were 25 years or older. In 1987, 40 percent of the commitments were 24 years or younger and 60 percent were 25 years or older.

## A Description of 1987 Commitments

In this section the 10,818 offenders committed to county facilities during 1987 will be described in more detail. Characteristics of the present offense will be discussed first and personal background characteristics of the county offender population will be discussed second. Information for each institution for these variables can be found in the following tables.

### Present Offense Characteristics

Institution Committed To. The number of commitments ranges from a low of 51 in Dukes County to a high of 2,041 in Middlesex County. Five counties received in excess of 1,000 commitments in 1987: Middlesex (N=2,041), Worcester (N=1,850), Essex (N=1,138), Hampden (N=1,136), and Suffolk - Deer Island (N=1,131). These five counties accounted for two-thirds (67 percent) of all county commitments in 1987.

Present Offense. Most offenders committed to county facilities were sentenced for non-violent offenses (87 percent). Only 13 percent were committed for violent offenses, those against the person or sex offenses.

Eleven percent of the commitments were for offenses against the person. Most of these were for armed assault (assault and battery with a dangerous weapon or assault with a dangerous weapon) or unarmed assault (assault or assault and battery). There were 55 commitments for vehicular homicide.

Two percent of the commitments were for sex offenses including 38 for rape, 122 for assault with intent to rape (which includes indecent assault and battery), and 31 for other sex offenses (e.g., lewdness, indecent exposure). Of the 160 commitments for rapes and sexual assaults, 106 involved minors as victims and 54 involved adults as victims.

Twenty-eight percent of the commitments were for property offenses. The most common property offenses were: burglary (N=960), larceny (N=687), receiving stolen goods (N=339), vehicle theft (N=286), and property injury (N=218).

Nine percent of the commitments were for drug offenses. Most of these were for violation of the Controlled Substance Act with Class A, Class B, or Class D substances.

Forty-nine percent of all commitments were in the "other" offense category. Most of these commitments are for O.U.I. (N=2,607) and other motor vehicle violations (N=1,420). Other offenses in this category are disturbing the peace (N=357), weapons (N=184), and non-support (N=160).

**Sentence.** The median sentence length for 1987 commitments was three months. In general, offenders sentenced for less than two months will serve their entire sentence, and offenders sentenced for two months or more will be eligible for parole after half their sentence is served. There were 1,256 (12 percent) commitments in lieu of payment of a fine. County sentences range up to two and one-half years, but in a small number of cases, offenders can serve consecutive sentences of two and one half years or less, such that the total length of sentence will be more than two and one half years.

Some sentences are served only on weekends. One percent of all commitments were weekend sentences. Weekend sentences were used most extensively in Berkshire county where 6 percent of all commitments were served on weekends.

Most offenders are sentenced to houses of correction, but some offenders are committed to jails. In 1987 there were 102 such jail commitments (about one percent of all commitments). Almost all of these were to the Suffolk County Charles Street facility and were generally for illegitimacy (i.e. child support) or non-support.

**Court from Which Committed.** Most offenders committed to county facilities are sentenced by the lower courts in the county to which they are committed. Ninety-four percent were from lower courts and 6 percent were from Superior courts.

### **Personal Background Characteristics**

**Sex.** Of the 10,818 commitments to county facilities, there were 32 females and 10,786 males. Females are only housed at four county facilities: Berkshire, Dukes, Franklin and Hampden WMCAC. All other females receiving a county sentence are sent to the state correctional facility for female offenders, MCI-Framingham. Females committed to other facilities were transferred to the Hampden WMCAC facility, or were released the same day they were committed.

**Race.** The majority of offenders were white (76 percent). Sixteen percent were black and 8 percent were Hispanic. There were 51 individuals (less than one percent) in other racial groups. At two facilities, the majority of commitments were not white. Suffolk-Charles Street (81 percent black and 9 percent Hispanic) and Suffolk-Deer Island (52 percent black, 11 percent Hispanic, and one percent other).

**Age.** The age of offenders ranged from 16 years to 77 years. The median age was 26 years. There were 1,868 offenders (17 percent) age 20 years or younger and 65 (1 percent) age 60 and over.

**Marital Status.** Most offenders were single (70 percent). Seventeen percent were married at the time of commitment and 13 percent were separated, divorced or widowed.

**Education.** The median educational level was 12th grade. Eight percent had only a grade school education (first through eighth grade), 41 percent completed some high school and 51 percent were at least high school graduates. Nine percent had at least some college education and 2 percent report having a college degree.

**Place of Birth.** Seventy percent of all county commitments were born in Massachusetts, 18 percent were born in other states, 8 percent were born in U.S. territories and 4 percent were foreign-born. Suffolk-Charles Street had the highest proportion of foreign-born (14 percent); Hampden County had the highest proportion of offenders born in U.S. territories (20 percent); Dukes County had the highest proportion born in other states (35 percent); and Berkshire County had the highest proportion born in the same county as the facility (70 percent).

**Residence.** As reported by the county facilities, all but 313 offenders committed to county facilities were residing in Massachusetts at the time of commitment. In most cases, the offenders were residing in the same county as the facility to which they were committed. The Hampden County and Berkshire County facilities had the highest proportion of county residents (92 percent) and Norfolk County had the lowest proportion of county residents (55 percent).
