**Three weeks prior to construction, major modification, installation or relocation of any Tramway, the Ski Area Operator must submit to the Board the following information for approval. See 526 CMR 10.13.**

Sections 2.1; 3.1; 4.1; 5.1; & 6.1 of the existing ANSI standard set forth certain requirements concerning the design and installation of all types of lifts. The following is a check list to be used as you proceed with your design and installation. Use and adhere to these requirements to prevent any delay in the approval and licensing of your lift.

1. Copy of building permit issued by the local building official. *See 780 CMR 116.*

2. Before constructing any new passenger tramway, the owner/operator of the ski area must submit to the Board for its approval, a profile of the lift line showing proximity to power lines, highways, or rivers, together with an application for its construction on forms prescribed by the Board. *See 526 CMR 10.13(1)(a).*

3. A set of specifications and plans must be furnished to the Board showing all footing details and designed sheave loads. *See 526 CMR 10.13(1)(a).*

4. The design and installation of all lifts must be under the supervision of a Professional Engineer. The design and installation of all terminals and towers and other tramway structures must be approved by a Massachusetts Registered Professional Engineer. *See 526 CMR 10.13(1)(a).*

5. Please be advised that before concrete is placed for either towers or terminal foundations, notice shall be given to the Board at least five (5) business days in advance of the placement. *See* 526 CMR 10.13(1)(c). The Board may require test reports on the concrete from a recognized testing laboratory.
6. Installations may not be put in service without written authorization from the Board. Before this time only those directly concerned with constructing or outfitting the tramway may be transported on said installation.
