

3. An individual who is licensed in compliance with M.G.L. c. 146 § 85 as a refrigeration technician may connect or disconnect for the purpose of alteration, repair or replacement of controls downstream of the equipment gas shutoff valve any device or control that is regulated by 522 CMR or is an integral part of the refrigeration or air conditioning equipment. All fuel gas piping shall be installed by said licensed technician in compliance with 248 CMR 3.00 through 11.00.
