COURSE OBJECTIVE: TO ASSIST LAW ENFORCEMENT WITH REDUCING DEATH AND SERIOUS INJURIES BY PLACING AN EMPHASIS ON THE COGNITIVE SKILLS REQUIRED FOR OFFICER SURVIVAL

COURSE DELIVERY: THE COURSE CONTENT INCLUDES LECTURE, INTERACTIVE DISCUSSION, ANALYSIS OF LEOKA DATA, VIDEO INTERVIEWS WITH SURVIVING OFFICERS AND OFFENDERS

COURSE DESCRIPTION: THIS PROGRAM RELIES ON A DETAILED ANALYSIS OF THE DEADLY MIX INVOLVING OFFICERS, OFFENDERS AND THE CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH THEY COME TOGETHER THAT RESULT IN DEATH OR SERIOUS BODILY INJURY TO POLICE OFFICERS. DEMOGRAPHIC AND BEHAVIORIAL DESCRIPTORS OF VICTIM OFFICERS AND OFFENDERS WILL BE DISCUSSED, AS WILL THE RECURRING CIRCUMSTANCES UNDER WHICH POLICE OFFICERS ARE MOST OFTEN KILLED OR INJURED.

NORTHEAST AND INTERNATIONAL FBI LEOKA INSTRUCTOR BILL BAKER:

Chief William D. Baker is a 36 year veteran of law enforcement. He has been a Police Chief in Massachusetts, New Hampshire & Maine; he served as Director of Police Training, Commissioner & Assistant Secretary of Public Safety in Massachusetts; he has trained and mentored national police leaders in more than 30 countries around the world as Assistant Director of International Training for the United States Department of Justice in Washington DC; and has patrolled cities such as Moscow Russia, Odessa Ukraine, Guatemala City Guatemala, Kampala Uganda & Port au Prince Haiti. He concluded his full time law enforcement career in February of 2011 as Chief of Police in the City of Westbrook Maine where he maintained his career long commitment to front line officers by working the streets with his officers, making arrests, and engaging in tactical use of force situations right up to his last day on duty. Chief Baker is also a lawyer and has served as an expert witness defending police officers falsely accused of excessive force. Chief Baker is a graduate of the 129th Session of the FBI National Academy and served for many years as Secretary to the New England Chapter. Chief Baker is one of five national instructors for LEOKA.
