

DECISION OF THE BOARD: Based on the August 12, 2016 decision of the Supreme Judicial Court, Frederick Clay v. Massachusetts Parole Board, Frederick Clay is to be granted parole. Therefore, parole is granted to a long term treatment program, with special conditions, after successful completion of 12 months in lower security.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS: Waive Work for Participation in Treatment Program; Must be at home between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.; Electronic Monitoring – GPS at Parole Officer’s discretion for first six months; Supervise for drugs and liquor abstinence; Report to assigned MA Parole Office on day of release; Long Term Residential Treatment Program (LTRP); Adjustment Counseling upon completion of LTRP; No contact or association with victim’s family
