ADDITIONAL LEGAL OR PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT(S) WITH A PUBLIC AGENCY

WHEN TO USE THIS DISCLOSURE FORM

You already are a **special public employee** by reason of performing contracted legal or other professional services for a public agency. You **may have a financial interest in a contract or contracts made by the same public agency** if you comply with this exemption.

You are **eligible** for this exemption only if you **did not participate in or have official responsibility for**, the contents, design, making, or award of the additional contract.

In addition, you must meet one of the following two requirements:

EITHER

• The additional contract was awarded as the result of a **competitive selection process** in accordance with applicable law or agency policy

OR

- Consistent with applicable public procurement law and agency policy, the agency head certifies
 in writing that a legitimate public purpose will be served by permitting the additional contract and
 provides a sole source justification for that contract.
 - A legitimate public purpose means that the public will obtain an identifiable advantage from the use of your services under an additional contract.

Before you commit to any financial interest in an additional contract, you must file a disclosure and provide any necessary certification or sole source justification.

FILING THE DISCLOSURE

Complete the **disclosure** form below.

If necessary, get a written certification from the agency head and a sole source justification for the contract.

State and county employees should file the disclosure with the State Ethics Commission.

Municipal employees should file the disclosure with the city or town clerk.
