FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A GENERAL SCHOOL FEE

WHEN TO USE THIS DISCLOSURE FORM

You are a member of a School Committee or a charter school Board of Trustees.

The School Committee or charter school Trustees will be considering a particular matter regarding a general school fee.

 A general school fee means a fee, waiver or exemption established by a school committee or charter school board of trustees for a school service, program or activity. It includes, for example, fees for school bus transportation, preschool or after school programs, sports or extracurricular activities. It does not include a fee that applies to a single event or the children of a single family.

You have a **child in the school system** -- your biological child, adopted or pre-adoptive child, foster child, ward, or step-child -- and **the general school fee will affect your child**

Before you participate in any discussion or vote about the general school fee, you must complete a written disclosure explaining how the school fee would affect your child.

If the school fee applies only to a single event or only to your child, you may not participate and you do not need to file a disclosure.

FILING THE DISCLOSURE

Complete the **disclosure** form below.

A charter school trustee should file the disclosure with the State Ethics Commission.

A school committee member should file the disclosure with the city or town clerk.

A regional school committee member should file the disclosure with the clerk or secretary of the regional school committee.
