**LIST OF MCC GRANT PROGRAMS**

**ADAMS ARTS PROGRAM:** Support through the disbursement of cultural economic development grants including grants for cultural activities that have the capacity to revitalize communities, stimulate income, create or enhance jobs, and attract tourism.

**ARTIST FELLOWSHIPS:** Fellowships to artists in recognition of exceptional work.

**CREATIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT: BIG YELLOW SCHOOL BUS:** Provides grants to help schools meet the costs of providing educational field trips to cultural institutions and events across the Commonwealth.

**CULTURAL FACILITIES FUND:** An initiative of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; the goal of the Fund is to increase investments from both the public sector and the private sector to support the sound planning and development of cultural facilities in Massachusetts. **NOTE-** Under the legislation governing this program, the grantees for this program are originated by MCC and recommended for funding to MassDevelopment.

MassDevelopment makes the final decisions and funds the approved grants from funding made available to it for the program.

**CULTURAL INVESTMENT PORTFOLIO:** A fresh approach to unrestricted funding for nonprofit arts, humanities, and interpretive science organizations. Not a traditional grant program, but a partnership that will better position the cultural sector as vital components of Massachusetts' economy and the quality of life of our citizens.

**LOCAL CULTURAL COUNCIL PROGRAM:** Local Cultural Councils serving every city and town in Massachusetts offer grants to projects benefiting their community.

**REGRANT/PROJECT PROGRAMS:** Includes: A cooperative program with the Massachusetts Foundation for the Humanities pursuant to which the MCC provides support to partner arts and humanities organizations for their programs; A pass-through grant to the Huntington Theater for the National Endowment for the Arts' "Poetry Out Loud" program is also included in this category; Project-funding to New England Foundation for the Arts (NEA's regional arts organization for New England) for the New England States Touring program which benefits Massachusetts artists and presenter venues and other regional projects benefitting Massachusetts.

**CREATIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT: STARS RESIDENCIES:** Grants to schools for residencies of 3 days or more with teaching artists, scientists, scholars, or cultural organizations.

**TRADITIONAL ARTS APPRENTICESHIPS:** A part of the Folk Arts and Heritage Program, apprenticeships support the teaching of traditional arts that are specific to a particular folk group or ethnic community.

**CREATIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT: YOUTHREACH:** Multi-year grants for partnerships that provide substantive arts activities for vulnerable young people.

Additionally two other programs will be kicked off in FY 15- UP focusing on accessibility, inclusivity and universal design and SERHACER, a Creative Youth Development program focusing on community music programs and the "El Sistema" model.

# ATTACHMENT A

## PART 1

### Massachusetts Cultural Council Performance - FY2014 Strategic Plan

In September 2012, the Massachusetts Cultural Council (MCC) undertook a process to set goals and targets based on its 2013-2018 Strategic Plan (which can be reviewed at <http://www.massculturalcouncil.org/about/plan.asp>). That effort was further improved in FY 2014 when the MCC assigned a senior staff member the direct responsibility for further clarifying the effort in terms of available data collection and improvements learned in the first year of the process

As part of that effort and in coordination with OPMO, MCC developed and then further refined a series of measures to track not only MCC's progress on its broad long-term goals, but also to measure achievement in each of the separate programs in the fiscal years that followed. Last year, the MCC adapted and aligned these goals to the Fiscal 2014 Business Plan format required by the Commonwealth's Office of Performance Management & Oversight. Subsequently, the MCC adjusted some of its goal measures as a result of its refinement process but has kept the same goals as set forth in the FY 14 Business Plan

The goals set by the MCC fall into the four following categories that align with the goals of the MCC's strategic plan:

1. **RESOURCES**- Increasing the pool of financial resources available for the arts, sciences and humanities in the Commonwealth
2. **GRANTMAKING**-Improving the process and results for investing state dollars in cultural organizations, local cultural councils, schools and artists
3. **CULTURAL PARTICIPATION & TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE**- Assist cultural organizations, local cultural councils, schools and artists with tools and skills to thrive.
4. **AWARENESS & HEALTHY COMMUNITY BUILDING**-Advocate effectively about the power of the arts, sciences and humanities to build healthy, livable communities.

**NOTES**

- This table only counts grants directly paid out by MCC plus the CFF grants (described below) made in FY 14. Actual grants approved in FY 14 also included 29 grants for an additional \$18,000 in the Big Yellow School Bus (25) and Cultural Investment Portfolio (4) programs but these amounts reverted to the MCC due to grantees being unable to either complete the project or comply with the required terms of the grant.
- Folk Arts and Heritage Apprentice grants are only made in odd-numbered fiscal years. In even-numbered years, folk and traditional artist artists may apply for traditional arts fellowships and these are counted under the “Artists Grants” in the table above. In FY 14, \$22,000 in fellowship and finalists awards were made to traditional artists
- Cultural Facilities Fund grants are originated by MCC and funded by MassDevelopment. The program is funded by an allocation from the commonwealth’s capital plan (not the MCC annual budget). The capital allocation for FY 14 (\$15 million) was three times larger than the prior allocation. This is a reimbursement grant program and the funds will be expended over several fiscal years.

- Re-Grant/Project Programs refer to federal programs such as (1) Poetry Out Loud (a National Endowment for the Arts-funded program), (2) project-funding to New England Foundation for the Arts (NEA's regional arts organization for New England) for the New England States Touring program which benefits Massachusetts artists and presenter venues and (3) a contribution made pursuant to the MCC Enabling Act (MGL ch. 10 sec. 55) to the Massachusetts Foundation for the Humanities, the National Endowment for the Humanities' constituent organization in the Commonwealth. The amount granted to MassHumanities is based on a formula but can fluctuate from year to year depending upon which year's from which it is paid.
- Grant to Local Cultural Councils are here reflected as the actual allocations to the 329 separate local councils in the state not as the separate regrants made by each of those councils (although we did use data on those individual regrants for purposes of a measurement of the MCC applications from and grants to "underserved communities" for a FY 14 performance measure.


