Accompanying the seventh recommendation of the Board of Education (House, No. 4). Education.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO HORACE MANN CHARTER SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 89(b) of chapter 71 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking out the words “and by the local collective bargaining
4 agent” in lines 10 through 11.

1 SECTION 2. Section 89(u) of chapter 71 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the words “the terms of its charter” in lines 228
4 through 229 and after the words “said school’s charter” in line 235
5 the following:— and agreed to by the local collective bargaining
6 agent.

1 SECTION 3. Section 89(x) of chapter 71 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the words “district’s budgetary allocation rules” in
4 line 274 the following language:— If a district allocates expenses
5 to schools using a formula and actual expenditures are available,
6 the district shall use the lesser of formula expenditures or actual
7 expenditures.

1 SECTION 4. Section 89(x) of chapter 71 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting after the words “such school” in line 277 the
4 following:— within thirty days of receipt of all submissions.
