AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR JANICE BROWN AN EMPLOYEE OF THE APPELLATE TAX BOARD.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to  
2 defeat its purpose, which is to establish forthwith a sick leave  
3 bank for a certain employee of the appellate tax board, therefore it  
4 is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the  
5 immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, or rule or regula-  
2 tion to the contrary, the appellate tax board and the house of rep-  
3 resentatives shall establish a sick leave bank for Janice Brown, an  
4 employee of the appellate tax board and a former employee of the  
5 house of representatives. Any employee of said appellate tax  
6 board and said house of representatives may voluntarily contribute  
7 1 or more sick, personal or vacation days to said sick leave bank  
8 for use by said Janice Brown.
