RESOLVE CREATING A STUDY INTO THE PROMOTION OF A YEAR OF SERVICE
BY YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE COMMONWEALTH.

1 *Resolved*, That a special commission consisting of Two mem-
2 bers of the Education Committee of the Senate; Two Members of
3 the Education Committee of the House; Two members of the
4 Senate Committee on Children and Families; Two members of the
5 House Committee on Children and Families; the Commissioner of
6 Education; the Chancellor of Higher Education; the Commissioner
7 of the Department of Youth Services; the Executive Director of
8 City Year Boston; and the Chief Executive Officer of the Boys
9 and Girls Clubs of Massachusetts, or such a designee as appointed
10 by the above listed persons with the purpose of examining and
11 promoting of a year of public service by young people in the
12 Commonwealth and the effects of such service on the individual
13 and the community.

14 Said commission shall report to the General Court the results of
15 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
16 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
17 mendations into effect by filing the same with the Clerk of the
18 House of Representatives on or before the first Wednesday in
19 November, two thousand and seven.
