AN ACT RELATIVE TO SELF SERVICE GASOLINE STATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 22 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official
2 Edition is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the
3 following section:—

4 Section 21. The department of public safety is hereby authorized
5 and directed to promulgate regulations allowing employees of a one-
6 employee self-service service station that sells motor fuel to be able to
7 render service to any motorist with a car bearing handicapped person
8 or disabled person license plates as described in section two of chapter
9 ninety. Any service station covered by these regulations shall sell
10 gasoline to the handicapped or disabled person at the self-service
11 price.
