AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROTECTING THE RIGHTS OF CUSTODIAL AND OTHER  
NON TEACHING EMPLOYEES OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 59B of Chapter 71 is hereby amended by adding the  
2 following words at the end of the first paragraph: “In the case of  
3 custodial, maintenance and non-teaching positions, the hiring,  
4 promotion and firing of such employees shall be completed in  
5 accordance with the provisions of Chapter 31 of the General Laws  
6 provided that said positions are classified as civil service posi-  
7 tions. For those positions not covered by civil service, the hiring,  
8 promotion and firing of such employees shall be completed in  
9 accordance with the provisions of the existing collective bargain-  
10 ing agreement.”
