AN ACT RELATIVE TO AUTO INSURANCE SURCHARGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary,
2 Section 113B of Chapter 175 of the General Laws, as appearing in
3 the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line
4 221, after the word “incident.”, the following sentence:— “Driving a
5 motor vehicle that has an expired inspection sticker shall not be con-
6 sidered a surchargeable incident.”
