AN ACT TO ENCOURAGE TOMORROW'S TEACHERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 19D of Chapter 15A of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following para-  
3 graph:—

5 Temporary substitute teaching in a public school in the Common-  
6 wealth shall be deemed satisfactory to meet the obligations on the  
7 participants in the program pursuant to subsections (1) and (3) of  
8 this section.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be  
2 retroactive to January 1, 2003.
