AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE USE OF THE MCAS FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 1D of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 2000 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding after the word
3 “graduation” in line 59 the following words: —; provided however,
4 that the MCAS test, so called, or other state-developed, standardized
5 test, shall not be a component of the competency determination.
