AN ACT RELATIVE TO INDEPENDENT VOTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapters 50 through 57 inclusive of the General
2 Laws are hereby amended by substituting the words “independent
3 voter” for the phrase “unenrolled voter” wherever the phrase “unen-
4 rolled voter” appears.

1 SECTION 2. The phrase “unenrolled voter” shall be changed to
2 “independent voter” wherever it appears in the regulations promul-
3 gated pursuant to Chapters 50 through 57 of the General Laws.
