AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN EXPENDITURES BY SOME NON PROFIT CORPORATIONS ON BALLOT QUESTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 180 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2000 official
2 edition is hereby amended by inserting after Section 4 the following
3 new section:—

4 Section 4A Rebate of Certain Expenditures by some Non-Profit
5 Corporations.

6 A corporation incorporated under this chapter or incorporated by
7 a special act and governed by this chapter which engages in the pro-
8 curement of health care services and which files an annual statement
9 of condition with the commissioner of insurance or is otherwise gov-
10 erned in any way by chapter 176G of the general laws which makes
11 an expenditure reportable under Chapter 55 Section 22 on a question
12 proposal to the voters shall credit to the fees or premium paid by
13 members as a proportioned cost of the expenditures on the ballot
14 question if the member objects in writing to the expenditure.
