AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PESTICIDE CONTROL ACT.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Chapter 132B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2002 Offi-
- 2 cial Edition, is hereby amended by adding after Section 6E, the
- 3 following new section:—
- 4 Section 6EE. If a school administration, day care center operator,
- 5 or school age child care program operator determines its facilities do
- 6 not experience vermin pest infestations in the present or past, and do
- 7 not take pest management measures beyond routine and normal
- 8 maintenance and cleaning, they may elect to opt out of the provi-
- 9 sions of sections 6C through 6E, inclusive, of this chapter.
