AN ACT RELATIVE TO CATCHBASIN CLEANING FACILITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     No catchbasin cleaning facility or materials handling facility shall  
2     be located in an area which is less than one-half mile in linear dis-  
3     tance from a playground, school, area of critical environmental con-  
4     cern as determined by the secretary of environmental affairs  
5     pursuant to 301 CMR 12.00, or area occupied by residential housing  
6     in the Charlestown neighborhood of Boston, or in the cities of  
7     Everett and Somerville. Said linear distance shall be measured from  
8     the outermost perimeter of such facility to the outermost point of the  
9     aforementioned zones; provided, however that any such facility in  
10    operation on January 1, 2007 shall not be subject to the provisions of  
11    this act.
