AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE DIVISION OF URBAN PARKS AND RECREATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The 4th paragraph of Section 1 of Chapter 21 of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the 2004 Official Edition, is hereby amended
3 by adding the following 3 sentences:—

4 The division of urban parks and recreation shall retain all rev-
5 enues generated by parks, beaches and recreational facilities under
6 their jurisdiction for their own purposes. 60 percent of the funds
7 generated at a facility shall be used for said facility and 40 percent
8 shall go to the division's general fund. All licensing fees generated
9 by the division shall go to the division's general fund.
