## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT STATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 73 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2002 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding  
3 the following paragraph:—

4 The board of trustees of the state colleges shall adopt rules and  
5 regulations prohibiting the possession or use of alcoholic beverages  
6 by students on campus. Said regulations shall provide that any stu-  
7 dent deemed to physically or psychologically impair due to alcohol  
8 presumption, whether such impairment occurs on or off campus  
9 shall be subject to expulsion.

1 SECTION 2. Section 1A of Chapter 75 of the General Laws, as  
2 so appearing, is hereby amended by adding the following  
3 paragraph:—

4 The board of trustees for the University of Massachusetts
