AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR FACULTY REPRESENTATION ON THE UNIVERSITY OF MASSACHUSETTS BOARD OF TRUSTEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 1A of Chapter 75, of the Massachusetts General Laws as  
2 appearing in the 2000 Official Edition is hereby amended by striking  
3 out the second sentence and inserting in place thereof the  
4 following:—  
5 “Two members shall be full-time students from said institution,  
6 five members shall be faculty from said institution, one elected from  
7 each campus annually by the Faculty Senate and twelve members  
8 shall be appointed by the Governor, at least five of whom shall be  
9 alumni of said institution, and one of whom shall be a representative  
10 of organized labor who shall be appointed by the Governor from a  
11 list of not more than five names, representing different unions sub-  
12 mitted by the Massachusetts Building Trades Council.”
