AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHAPTER 40B HOUSING, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No applications shall be received pursuant to Section 21 of
2 Chapter 40B of the General Laws until such time as the office of the
3 inspector general completes an audit being conducted by the office
4 of the program established by Sections 20 to 23 inclusive is com-
5 plete and a review of the profit levels of developers employing such
6 program is undertaken by the office of the general court.
