AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE COLLECTION OF JUDGEMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 22 of Chapter 235 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the
- 3 following sentence:—
- 4 Any court proceedings necessary to satisfy an execution shall take
- 5 place in the jurisdiction of the judgment holder.
