AN ACT AUTHORIZING EOPS TO PROMULGATE REGULATIONS FOR A SEX OFFENDER EMAIL REGISTRY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 18¾ of Chapter 6A, as appearing in the 2004 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following clause:—
- 3 (9) to adopt regulations relative to the issuance that require con-
- 4 victed sex offenders in the Commonwealth to register their e-mail
- 5 addresses and instant messaging (IM) identities with the Common-
- 6 wealth of Massachusetts Sex Offender Registry Board.
