AN ACT REALTIVE TO THE VACATION TIME OF A CERTAIN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, and in
- 2 order to satisfy a moral obligation, John J. McAuliffe, an employee
- 3 of the trial court of the Commonwealth, shall be entitled to 5 weeks
- 4 of vacation, annually.
