**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year Two Thousand and Seven.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR KAREN WHITE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation  
2 to the contrary, the trial court of the commonwealth shall establish a  
3 sick leave bank for Karen White, an employee of the Chelsea divi-  
4 sion of the district department of the trial court. Any employee of the  
5 trial court may voluntarily contribute 1 or more sick, personal or  
6 vacation days to said sick leave bank for use by said Karen White.  
7 Whenever said Karen White terminates employment with the trial  
8 court or request to dissolve the sick leave bank, the balance of the  
9 sick leave time shall be transferred to the trial court paid leave bank.
