AN ACT RELATIVE TO ASSISTANT REGISTERS OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 36, Section 4 is hereby amended by deleting the first sen-
- 2 tence and inserting in place thereof the following:
- 3 Each register may appoint an assistant register of deeds, remov-
- 4 able at his pleasure, for whose official acts he shall be responsible;
- 5 provided, however, that any person so appointed by the register for
- 6 Suffolk county who has served continuously in any position in the
- 7 registry of deeds in said county for a period of twenty or more years
- 8 shall not be removed there from except for cause.
