AN ACT TO ALLOW INMATE WORK PROGRAMS TO BENEFIT CERTAIN
NONPROFIT INSTITUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The first paragraph of section 49C of chapter 127 of the General
- 2 Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the first sentence the
- 3 following new sentence:—
- 4 Said prisoners may also be eligible to provide services for duly
- 5 registered non-profit institutions located within the county.; and is
- 6 hereby further amended in the last sentence by adding after the
- 7 word, “persons”, the following new clause: “unless said person is a
- 8 duly registered non-profit institution located within the county.”
