AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON PERSONNEL STANDARDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 211B, Section 8 is amended by striking paragraph one
2 and inserting in place thereof:—
3 There shall be an advisory committee on personnel standards of
4 which the chief administrative justice of the trial court shall be
5 chairman, consisting of the chief administrative justice of the trial
6 court, the administrative justices of the superior, land, housing, pro-
7 bate and family, Boston municipal, juvenile, and district court
8 departments; and a superior court clerk, district court clerk, a juve-
9 nile court clerk, a housing court clerk, a register of probate, a land
10 court recorder, a clerk of the Boston municipal court, the president
11 of the superior court clerk’s association, and the president of the dis-
12 trict court clerk’s association, all of whom shall be designated by the
13 respective clerks-registers associations, and the commissioner of
14 probation.
