AN ACT RELATIVE TO CHILD LABOR LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws, as appearing, is hereby
2 amended in Section 78A, by striking out the second and third sen-
3 tences and inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—
4 “The citation may require a person:— (1) to comply immediately
5 with Sections 56 to 104, inclusive (2) for each willful violation of
6 any of those sections, to pay a civil penalty of not more than \$250
7 for the first offense, \$500 for the second offense, and \$2,500 for the
8 third and each subsequent offense; and (3) for each violation that is
9 not willful of any of those sections, to pay a civil penalty of not
10 more than \$100 for the first offense, \$200 for the second offense,
11 and \$500 for the third and each subsequent offense.”
