

HOUSE No. 1975

By Mr. Murphy of Weymouth, petition of James M. Murphy (with the approval of the mayor and town council) that the town of Weymouth be authorized to sell or convey a certain parcel of land held for water supply purposes. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.].

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WEYMOUTH TO MAKE CONVEYANCE
AND SALE OF CERTAIN WATER SUPPLY LAND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The Town of Weymouth acting by and through its Mayor may sell
2 and convey a certain parcel of land located within the Town of Wey-
3 mouth acquired for water supply purposes as a standpipe but no
4 longer used therefore, containing 58,587 square feet and recorded in
5 Norfolk County Registry of Deeds in Book 2771, Page 140, and
6 described therein as Parcel A on a plan entitled "Plan of Land in
7 East Wey. Mass." Dated Feb. 13, 1948 made by R.H. Whiting, C.E.
8 Town Engineer, and apply the proceeds there from for general
9 municipal purposes. Said parcel is shown on the Town of Weymouth
10 Assessors' Map as Sheet 22, Block 300, Lot 38.

11 Prior to the act taking effect upon its passage, the General Court
12 may make clerical or editorial changes to the bill and may make
13 other amendments within the scope of the general public objectives
14 of this petition, provided the same are approved by the Mayor prior
15 to enactment and final form by the General Court.
