AN ACT RELATIVE TO ELECTRIC STREET POLES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 34B of Chapter 164 of the General Laws as appearing
- 2 in the 2002 official edition is hereby amended by adding after the
- 3 word ‘pole;’ in line 5 the following:—
- 4 “Provided further, that a city or town may enforce this section
- 5 by the enactment of a local ordinance or bylaw prohibiting double
- 6 poles beyond the ninety days authorized by this section, violation
- 7 of which may be punishable by a fine not to exceed a maximum of
- 8 \$100 per occurrence per day.”
