AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF WELLESLEY TO ESTABLISH A GROUP INSURANCE LIABILITY FUND.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     SECTION 1. In Addition to the reasons for which voter  
2 approval may be sought as set forth in Section 21C of Chapter 59  
3 of the General Laws, but subject to the limitations set forth  
4 therein, the local appropriating authority of the Town of Wellesley  
5 may, by a two-thirds vote, seek voter approval at a regular or  
6 special election to assess taxes in excess of the amount allowed  
7 pursuant to said Section 21C for the purpose of funding said  
8 Town's Group Insurance Liability Fund, established by c.88 of the  
9 Acts of 2004, provided, however, that the question submitted shall  
10 be as follows:

11     “Shall the Town of Wellesley be allowed to assess an additional  
12 \$\_\_\_ in real estate and personal property taxes for each of the  
13 fiscal years in the period beginning July 1, \_\_\_\_, and ending June  
14 30, \_\_\_\_, for the purpose of funding said Town's Group Insurance  
15 Liability Fund?”

17 And provided, further, that said question shall be deemed  
18 approved if a majority of the persons voting thereon shall vote  
19 “Yes”.

1 SECTION 2. The Town may appropriate from the tax levy,  
2 from available funds, or from borrowing, contingent upon the pas-  
3 sage of the referendum questions under Section 1 of this Act, sub-  
4 ject to the provisions set forth in section (m) of said Section 21C  
5 of Chapter 59.

1 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its passage.
